Meeting Topics:

The meeting will be held for the following purposes:

1. Public Comment
2. Discuss, consider and take action regarding approval of the minutes from the October 20, 2023 meeting of the Board of Directors of the District.
3. Discussion and Possible Action relating to Exclusion of Lands from the District:
 - a. Continue deliberations relating to the exclusion of land or other property from the District proposed for exclusion at the public hearing conducted on October 20, 2023 including, without limitation, the following real property:
 - i Property located at 674 Buerger Lane, Seguin, Texas 78155 owned by Karen A. Aufderhaar;
 - ii Other property within the District identified for exclusion by landowners or by the Board of Directors.
 - b. Adopt Order excluding Property from the boundaries of the District and redefining the boundaries of the District pursuant to Section 49.307 of the Texas Water Code; and
 - c. Authorize such other action as may be necessary or convenient for the exclusion of Property from the District's boundaries.
4. Discussion and possible action relating to approval of Amendment to District Information Form to reflect revised District boundaries.
5. Discussion and possible action relating to approval of Memorandum of Understanding with the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority relating to the potential conveyance of the Lake Nolte Dam and Hydroelectric Facilities to the District and subsequent improvements to the dam facilities by the District.

6. Discussion and Possible Action regarding Future Meeting Dates.
